

## Is Your well Registered in Your Name?

When you purchased your rural property did you, your Realtor, or the title co transfer the well permit to your name? To Check:

- Go to [www.dwr.state.co.us/WellPermitSearch/default.aspx](http://www.dwr.state.co.us/WellPermitSearch/default.aspx)
- Select a search (Permit #, Owner, Subdivision, or Parcel ID)
- Click on Geographical Area and select Douglas from the pull down menu
- Click on Search which will pull up your permit info if you have the correct name or permit number
- At the bottom left of this page you may click on "View" to get any details the State has on your permit
- At the bottom under "Imaged Documents," you can click on each document on file

If your well is still registered in someone else's name, once you have the permit number you may download a transfer form from:

Complete the form and mail it to the State as per directions. There is no cost for this transfer so get it done today before you forget!

Can't find your name and don't know the well permit number?

- Go to the Douglas County Assessor's page (<http://www.douglas.co.us/assessor/index.html>) and find out **ALL** the previous owner names for your property. You need all of them as there may have been several owners but the original owner still has their name on the permit or it might be the 4th owner. Sometimes you have to check all of them to find the right one!
- Go back to the beginning of these instructions and search for the name of each previous owner in reverse chronological order
